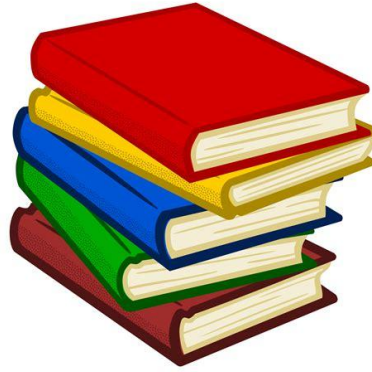




We have **three play reading activity groups** who get together in the home of each Group Leader for a relaxed and convivial two hours or so.
